Subject: Justin Inc RoHS Letter of Compliance

To Whom It May Concern:

In February 2003, the European Union issued Directive 2002/95/EC regarding the Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS).

The RoHS directive states that as of July 1, 2006 producers of electrical and electronic equipment must restrict the use of lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) and polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) in products sold in the European Union (EU). This restriction holds producers to maximum concentration values below those defined in the amendment to the RoHS Directive, Commission Decision 2005/618/EC dated August 18, 2005.

Based upon a careful review of our company's product specifications and the specifications reported by our suppliers, to the best of our knowledge the products Justin Inc declares as RoHS compliant do not contain any of the restricted substances above the maximum concentration values as defined above.
